Teaching English to Young Children

Program Focus :

This course is designed for students who wish to teach English in an elementary school or daycare setting. The program provides students with teaching methods which promote active learning in a fun and comfortable environment. Students will have the opportunity to observe young children at a daycare. Students will be required to create an ESL File, do presentations and a practicum.

Diploma :

All students with a passing grade of seventy percent or above will be given a TEYC diploma and a detailed report of his/her marks.

Admission Requirements :

All candidates wanting to take the TEYC Diploma Program at UCL must have a passing score on a written exam plus a half hour interview with the teacher trainer. Candidates for the program should have an Pre-Advanced level of English or TOEFL (CBT-180, IBT-64) , TOEIC 650

Out line :

With increasing demand over recent years, there is a need for qualified personnel to work with young children as Early Childhood Educators. This program aims to develop student competencies required for work in this rewarding field. In addition to specified weeks of observation and practicum, observation assignments are integrated into coursework to ensure a balanced combination of theory and practice starting from the very first module. The modular format of the Universal College of Language one-month TEYC diploma program gives students a real advantage in pursuing this career. TEYC is a highly intensive program designed for upper intermediate/advanced level ESL students who want to learn how to teach English to young children. Upon completion of the program, our teacher trainees receive a TEYC diploma and a letter of reference.

Program Focus :

This is an intensive program for students who have studied ESL and want to take another challenging course and continue practicing English. Designed for pre-advanced to advanced students, students learn English through business. Students will study business vocabulary and concepts, while practicing all language skills – speaking, listening, reading, and writing. By the end of the course, students should feel more comfortable making business presentations, reading difficult magazine articles, and using business-related vocabulary.

Diploma :

Upon successfully completing all tests, projects, and assignments, all graduating students receive the following:

- ▶ Business English Diploma (only for 2-month students)
- ▶ **FITT "Going Global: An Introduction to International Trade" Certificate (only for 2-month students)**
- ▶ Business English Certificate (for 1-month students)

Admission Requirements :

All candidates wanting to take the Business English course must have a minimum Pre-Advanced level of English or TOEFL (CBT)200 (IBT)72 ,TOEIC 700

Length : Diploma (2 months full-time), Certificate (1 month full-time)

Schedule :

- ▶ Business Fundamentals : learn business concepts/vocabulary, do team projects, practice job interviews
- ▶ Business Listening : listen to consumer-awareness/business-related programs, and do comprehension or cloze exercises
- ▶ Business Presentations : learn to do effective business presentations, conduct meetings and negotiations all North American style
- ▶ Business Writing : learn the common business letter types – North American style – including complaint and sales letters, memos, and resumes/cover letters all North American style
- ▶ Business Reading : read lengthy articles from business magazines such as Forbes or Fortune, and discuss the issues raised from each story, learn over forty useful vocabulary words a week
